UNICEF 2010

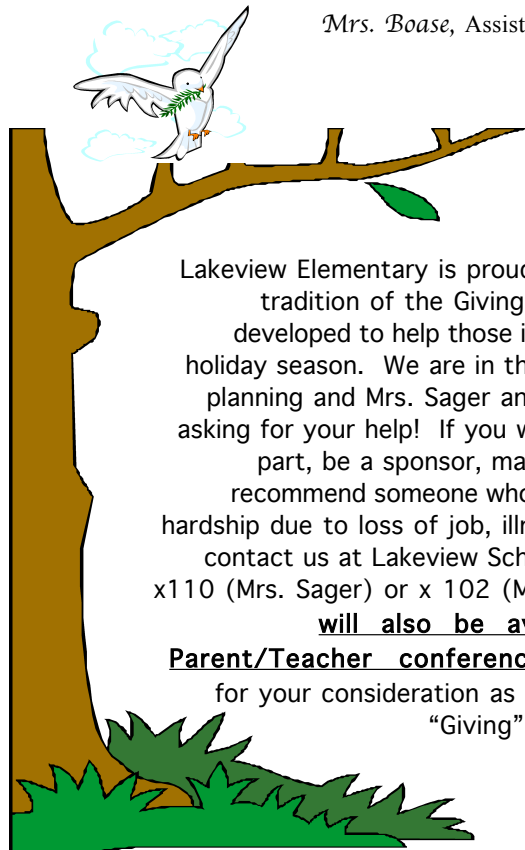

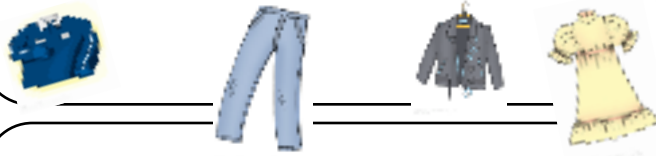
