

Reading Month activities are nearly finalized. Our theme this year is "Take Time to Read." We are encouraging all students and their families to attend our Family Reading Night on March 15th from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. When you make reading a priority at home it will become an individual priority for your child!

Here are three strategies we use at school that can very easily apply to reading at home. 1) When **SELECTING A BOOK** for your child to read, use the "five-finger rule" to make sure it is the appropriate level. (Have your child turn to the middle of the book and begin reading the page. Each time he/she encounters an unknown word, put up a finger. If he/she hits five words before finishing the page, the book is too difficult. If he/she doesn't put up any fingers, the book is probably too easy.) 2) Make reading a **PRIORITY**. Set aside a specific time each week or even small amounts of time each day. If you read when your child is reading that is even more powerful! 3) **NEVER STOP READING** to your child. It allows for time together and gives opportunity for families to communicate. Many read-alouds cover tough topics and encourage children to ask questions.

Our staff has planned an exciting month of activities to help encourage, promote, and embrace reading with your child in mind. You will soon be receiving a reading month calendar to help remind you of the opportunities for your child during reading month.

We hope to see you at **FAMILY READING NIGHT!!**
