## Changes Coming



This past fall, our student management software provider, PowerSchool, informed the school district that they would be discontinuing technical support for the software component, PowerLunch, which we are presently using. In response to this notice, we have been working to identify a new software provider which is compatible to PowerSchool and offers features to enhance our services while at the same time increasing the efficiency of our operation.

**Meal Magic** is the software product that was chosen by the district. Our plans are to begin using this new software on **Monday, March 14, 2011**. Each family, with children in the school district, will receive more information on this product in the very near future. We are planning to send, via US mail, information on how to access the new system, a site access student password and provide details on many new features you will be able to see from your child's account. The new software will be an all-in-one point of access to see menus, nutritional information, and purchase tickets on-line. The students themselves will see no difference from their prospective as we will continue to use the picture scan cards as lunch tickets.

Along with this new computer software being implemented for lunch and breakfast, we will also be adjusting our policy for students with a negative balance in their breakfast/lunch accounts. **Beginning on Monday, March 14, students with a negative account balance will receive an alternate meal, which will meet all the FDA and State guidelines.**
