## PENNY JUG WAR STUDENTS VERSUS STAFF

**KEEP THE CHANGE COMING!!!** The Lakeview Change Challenge (Penny Jug War) will kick off during the last week of February, starting Monday, February 22nd. The penny jug war is a competition between the grade levels and staff. The goal is for each grade level to raise the most pennies. Every day throughout the week of February 22nd, students will have an opportunity during lunch hour to put pennies in their grade level jug. They may also put silver coins or dollar bills in other grade level jugs to "take away" points from the other grade levels. The war has already started with the 100th day penny collection. The grade level that raises the most pennies will be awarded extra gym time and a yogurt parfait party.



The total money raised will be distributed as follows: 75% will be donated to UPDON (UP Diabetes Outreach Network) whose mission is "to promote innovated partnerships to strengthen diabetes prevention, detection, and treatment throughout the Upper Peninsula of Michigan," and 25% will be donated to Lakeview's new playground. So bring in those pennies and let the challenge begin!

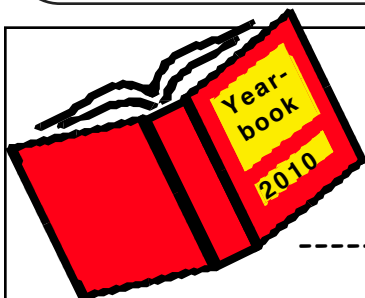
