From the Health Coordinator's Office

If your child has a chronic disease that requires the use of an inhaler or other emergency medication, please be sure that it is available for him/her at school. This is to ensure a safe learning environment for your child while at school. For example, asthmatics often may be triggered with an attack at any time and will need their rescue inhaler immediately. Students are allowed to transport their **emergency medication** in school with the consent of the parent. Remember, it is important to fill out the appropriate form verifying that he/she indeed needs the medication per school policy. The medication forms are available in the front office. Please refer to the Student Handbook for more information.

Immunization Updates:

Immunizations requirements have changed starting the 2010-2011 school year. Please review your child's vaccine record and/or inquire with your child's physician next time you bring your child to his/her doctor's appointment.

*Required for all children: need two doses of varicella or history of chickenpox disease.

*Required for all children 11-18 years: need one dose of meningococcal vaccine and one dose of Tdap vaccine if 5 years have passed since last dose of tetanus/diphtheria
