

Fun and numbers, do the two go together? The past few weeks at Lakeview they certainly have done just that. I would like to share a few numbers with you regarding our student body and recent activities. They are fun facts for you to reflect on and be proud of.

360 boys and 315 girls make up our student body at Lakeview. The Fifth Grade class is the largest with 115 and our Fourth Grade is the smallest with 89. Our average class size is 102. The First and the Third Grades are the only grades where girls outnumber the boys.

Our attendance numbers have stabilized and we are running full steam ahead. Students and teachers have weathered the illness that plagued the surrounding districts to the point of closing the doors. Lakeview takes pride in the fact that attendance is a top priority for students and teachers.

I would also like to inform you of the attendance percentage at our first Parent Power Hour. A grand total of 195 parents attended our mathematics session with their children over the course of a couple weeks. That is 30% of our students here at Lakeview. Our hope is that parents found it very valuable and pass the information on to others in the school community.



Finally, I would like to end by sharing with you that our student body participated in the memorial activities on November 11th. Nearly 100% of our student body was present to honor those who help make education possible for all children in the United States.

Great job, kids! Enjoy your much deserved pizza parties.



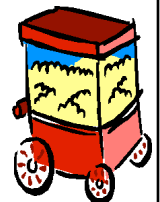
Popcorn was provided today.
