- **Box Tops For Education** - UPC barcodes off of many food products (cereal, frozen meals & snacks, refrigerated & dairy, natural organic, household & cleaning) *New: Download the **Box Tops Bonus App** and turn your everyday receipts into cash for our school. This bonus app is an additional program to the current program of clipping the UPC barcodes off of products and sending them in to the school.
- **Our Family Labels For Learning** - UPC barcodes off of Econo Foods "Our Family" brand products
- **Econo Foods Grocery Receipts**
- **Tags** - Tags from canned beverages are collected by the Elks in Negaunee and the money is used for projects for our local youth.
- **Shoparoo** - Download the app and choose Lakeview. We will receive money for each receipt you scan.
- **MightyNEst** - Users can pick Lakeview School as their school of choice and our school will receive a check each year off of the percentage purchased.

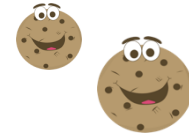
