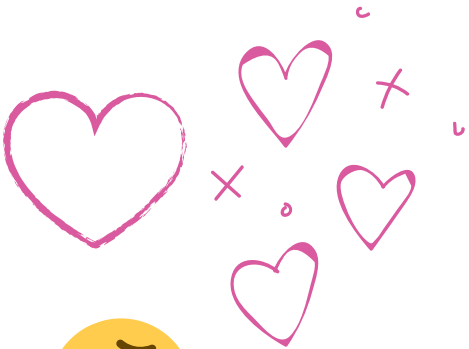
Hello Lakeview Families,

Please join us as we plan out some fun events this spring for our school. Babysitting will be available.

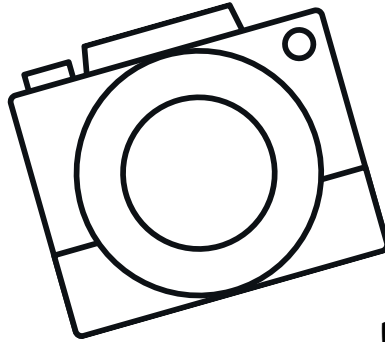

Free Preschool Development Screening!

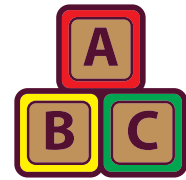
Do you know of a child in the Negaunee Public School district that will be **3 or 4 on or before September 1, 2020**? If so, please share this information with his/her parent or guardian.
